## What to Bring to Camp Quest Minnesota 2015

Please clearly mark all items with the camper's name. Camp Quest is not responsible for lost items.

- \_\_\_\_\_ Canteen or water bottle (seriously, bring at least one)
- \_\_\_\_\_ Bug spray
- \_\_\_\_\_ Sunscreen
- \_\_\_\_\_ Jacket and/or sweatshirt
- \_\_\_\_\_ Poncho or rain coat
- \_\_\_\_\_ Sturdy closed-toed shoes
- \_\_\_\_\_ Bathing suit and towel
- \_\_\_\_\_ Shorts and T-shirts
- \_\_\_\_\_ Long pants and long-sleeved shirt
- \_\_\_\_\_ Hat or cap
- \_\_\_\_\_ Night wear
- \_\_\_\_\_ Underwear and socks
- \_\_\_\_\_ Towel, washcloth or pouf, shampoo, soap or body wash
- \_\_\_\_\_ Toothbrush, toothpaste, (plastic) drinking cup, other personal hygiene items

Optional items could include a baseball ball glove, baseball, football, binoculars, books, cards, board games, etc. Music players may be used at designated times. Do not bring cellular phones.

## Getting to Camp

Camp address: 7000 County Road 15, Mound, MN. Earth coordinates: 44° 56' 27" N, 93° 42' 04" W.

### From the northern or central Twin Cities, or east or north of the Twin Cities

- Take I-394 west past I-494. The road will become US 12.
- Exit on County Road 15 (Shoreline Drive) west.
- Follow CR 15 west as it winds around Lake Minnetonka and continue west through Mound.
- We are located 1.5 miles west of Mound. VEC's entrance is on the right, on Steeler Street.

### From the southern Twin Cities, or south of the Twin Cities

- Follow I-494 west to Minnesota Highway 5 west. Continue west.
- Follow MN 5 to County Road 13. Turn right (north).
- Follow CR 13 to Minnesota Highway 7. Turn left (northwest).
- Follow MN 7 to County Road 44. Turn left (north).
- Follow CR 44 (becomes Westedge Blvd.) to County Road 15 (Lynwood Ave.). Turn left (west).
- Follow CR 15 west. VEC's entrance is about 1 mile west, on the right, on Steeler Street.
